
## **Bones of the Body Crossword Puzzle**



## Across

- **3.** Lower jaw, only moveable bone of the skull.
- **6.** Often called the tailbone, a region of the vertebrae.
- **7.** Smallest bone in the human body, located in the inner ear.

## **Down**

- **1.** Longest bone in the body, used to calculate stature in an equation.
- **2.** Generally the last epiphysis to fuse, between 18 and 25 years old.

- **8.** Number of bones the skull accounts for (written words).
- 11. Bones of the knees.
- **14.** Upper arm bone, your "funny bone".
- **16.** The shaft of a long bone.
- **18.** Area to best estimate sex from, besides the skull.
- **4.** Name for the bones of the toes and fingers.
- **5.** Lower arm bone that moves depending on hand position (palms facing up or down).
- **8.** Number of bones in the adult skeleton (written words).
- **9.** The ribs attach to this region of the vertebrae.
- **10.** The cap of a bone that fuses to the shaft.
- 12. Number of pairs of ribs (written words).
- **13.** Often referred to as the small of the back, this vertebrae region takes the most stress.
- **15.** Best area to estimate race/ancestry from.
- 17. Irregular interlocking joints of the cranium.
