

- **3.** large marine reptile with a bony or leathery shell and flippers.

- **9.** A gregarious burrowing plant-eating mammal, with long ears, long hind legs, and a short tail.
- **12.** A nocturnal bird of prey with large eyes, a facial disc, a hooked beak, and typically a loud hooting call.

- **14.** A large plant-eating marsupial with a long powerful tail and strongly developed hindlimbs.

- 1. A hoofed grazing or browsing animal, with branched bony antlers that are shed annually and typically borne only by the male.

- **5.** A fully grown female animal of a domesticated breed of ox, kept to produce milk or beef.
- **6.** A large mainly domesticated game bird native, having a bald head and (in the male) red wattles. It is a popular food on festive occasions such as Christmas and (in the US) Thanksgiving.
- **8.** A large African mammal with a very long neck and forelegs, having a coat patterned with brown patches separated by lighter lines. It is the tallest living animal.
