

- **3.** psychological disorders characterized by emotional extremes
- **5.** psychological disorder characterized by inflexible and enduring behavior patterns that impair social functioning

- **8.** American Psychiatric Assosciation's Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders
- **9.** psychological disorder that is usually distressing but allows one to think rationally and function socially
- **10.** mood disorder that alternates between the hopelessness and lethargy of depression and the overexcited state of mania
- **12.** atypical, disturbing, maladaptive, and unjustifiable behavior
- **13.** anxiety disorder that consists of unwanted repetitive thoughts and actions

- **6.** contemporary perspective which assumes that biological, psychological, and sociocultural factors combine and interact to produce psychological disorders
