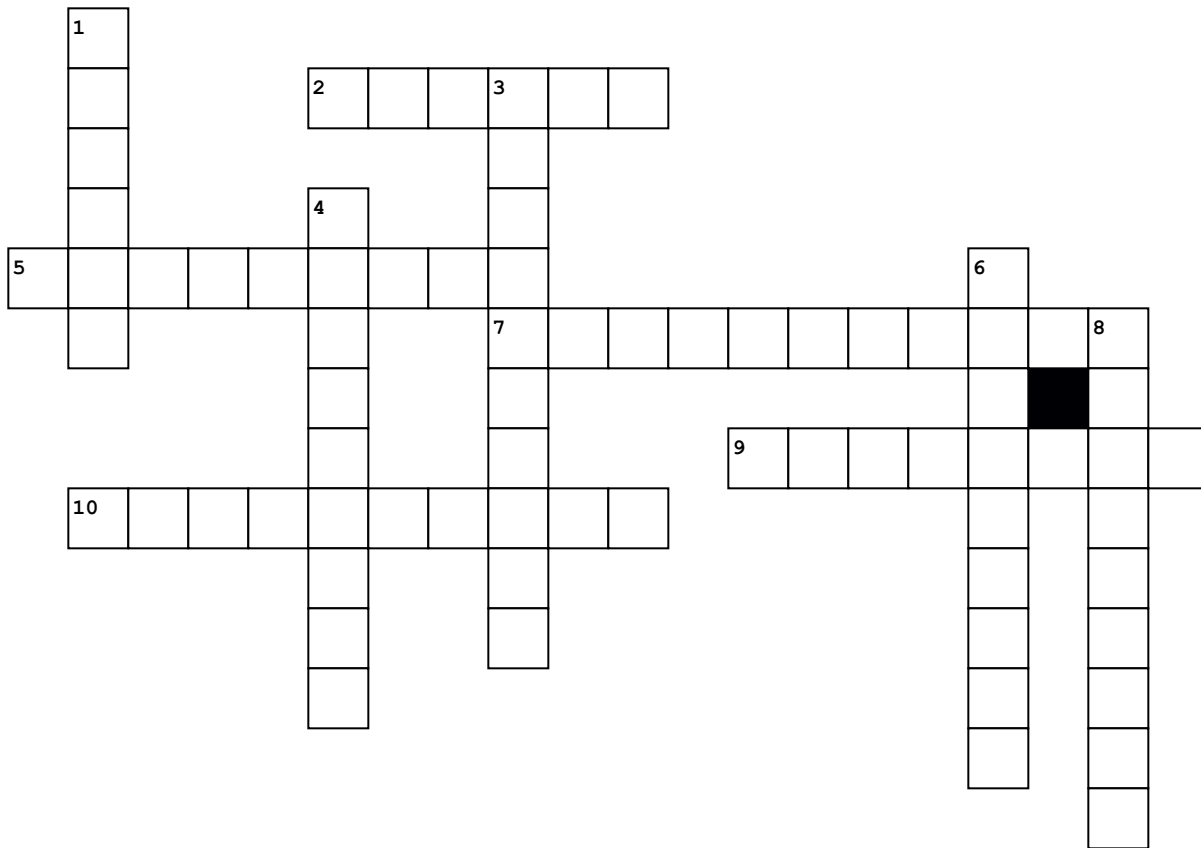


# Chapter 8: The Fundamentals of Investing
