
Parts of the house

- **1.** The space where the two sloping surfaces of the roof join
- **6.** A piece of baked clay that is used in rows for covering roofs
- 7. A small window in a roof
- **9.** A window that consists of two separate parts, one above the other that you open by sliding one of the parts up or down
- **10.** One of a pair of wooden or metal covers that can be closed over the outside of a window to keep out light or protect the windows from damage
- 11. The upper part of the end wall of a building, between the two sloping sides of the roof, that is shaped like a triangle

Down

- **2.** A wide hard path or a private road that leads from the street to a house
- **3.** The lower edges of a roof that stick out over the walls
- **4.** A large window, usually with glass on three sides, that sticks out from the outside wall of a house
- **5.** A narrow shelf below a window, either inside or outside
- **8.** A long curved channel made of metal or plastic that is fixed under the edge of a roof to carry away the water when it rains
