

- **20.** Named after Julius Caesar, this was the Roman word for Emperor

- 7. Time period (46BCE-476CE) when Rome was ruled as a dictatorship, power was invested in an emperor
- **10.** Capital city of modern day Italy, this city's history stretches back 2500+ years and was a center of Roman power.
- **12.** An elected member of the government who represents the people and helps make laws
- **14.** Like an adviser for the senate, spoke for the poor and had veto power.

- **18.** Boot shaped peninsula country of central southern Europe where Roman people came from.
