


Descending tracts



Across

- 4. sequence of motor activity is programmed
- 5. spinal and cranial motor neurons that innervate skeletal muscles
- 7. dorsiflection of great toe and fanning of other toes
- 10. found only in primary motor cortex
- 11. end on the cranial nerve nuclei
- 13. upside down representation of the body
- 14. decreased muscle tone
- 15. present in cortex and brain stems

Down

- 1. essential for controlling motor activity
- 2. final common pathway
- 3. found in Egypt
- 6. increased resistance to passive movement
- 8. controls posture and balance
- 9. modulate muscle tone
- 12. controls head and eye movements

16. initiated by cortex
