


# Earth, Moon, And Sun



## Across

- the relative size of things
- something we observe to be similar over and over again
- a moon phase that looks like a half-circle from Earth
- an object, diagram, or computer program that helps us understand something by making it simpler or easier to see
- a moon phase in which the Moon is not visible from Earth
- the sun, the planets that orbit the sun, and other objects that orbit the sun
- the amount of time it takes for a planet to complete one orbit around a star or stars
- a moon outside our solar system

## Down

- to shine light on an object and make it visible
- the star that is the main source of light at the center of our solar system
- when the Moon is completely dark
- the nearly circular path a smaller object (like the Moon) travels around a larger object (like Earth).
- a moon phase that looks like less than half a circle from Earth
- the border between light and dark on the Moon
- phase the shape of the illuminated part of the Moon as it appears from Earth
- moon a moon phase that looks like more than half a circle from Earth
- a moon phase that looks like a full circle from Earth
- a planet outside our solar system
- a rocky sphere that travels around a planet
