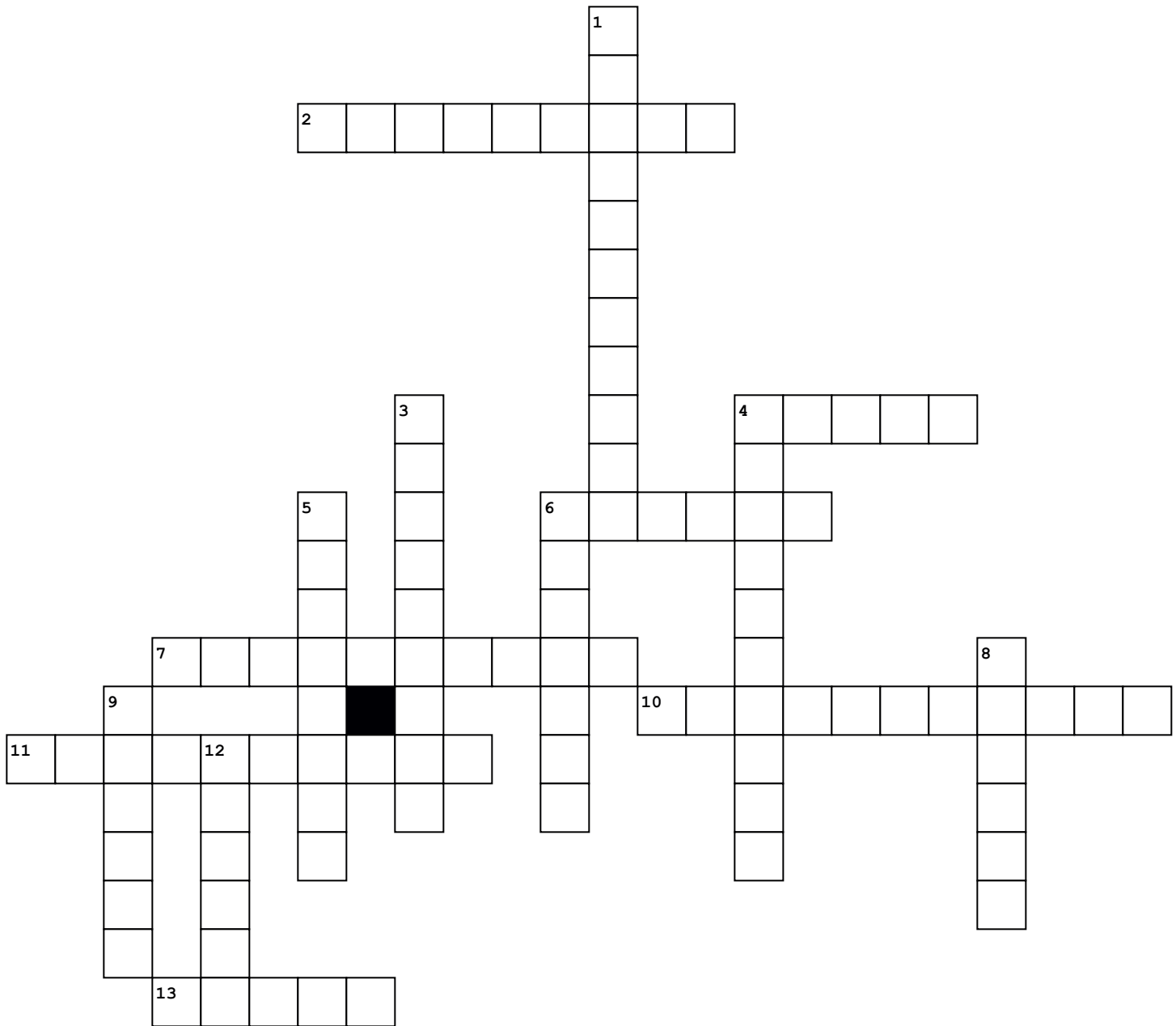


Elements of Graphic Novels
