


Parts of a Flower

4. Plants that bear seeds without fruit.
7. Green leaf-like structure that protects the flower bud.
8. Occurs when male pollen comes in contact with female ovules.
9. A flower with both male and female parts.

3. The ring of petals that surrounds the organs.
5. The female part of a flower.
6. Produces pollen grains that contain male gametes.
8. The most prominent part of the flower. Attracts pollinators.
