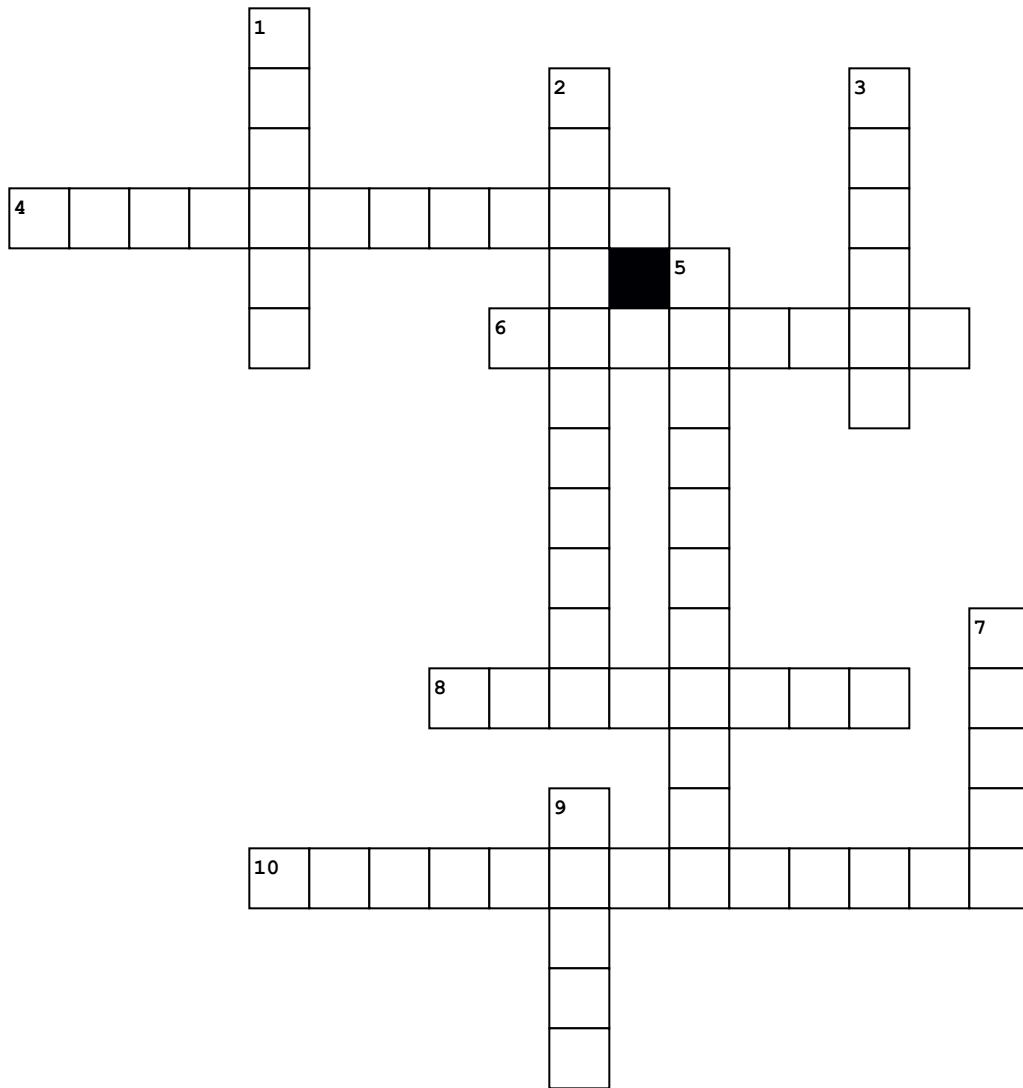


# Plants



## Across

4. Flowering plants, seeds enclosed in a fruit, most pollinated by birds and bees.
6. Have 1 seed leaf, parallel veins on leaves, flowers in multiples of 3, fibrous roots, vascular tissue scattered.
8. Have vessels to transport food and water, roots, stems, and leaves.
10. Plants respond to touch, growing around objects.

## Down

1. Transports food and nutrients.
2. "Naked seeds," needle-like leaves, usually stay green year round.
3. Have 2 seed leaves, net veins on leaves, flowers are in multiples of 4-5, taproots, vascular tissue in a ring.
5. No vessels, no roots, no stems or leaves.
7. Transports water.
9. Anchors the plant into the ground, absorbs water and nutrients from the soil.
