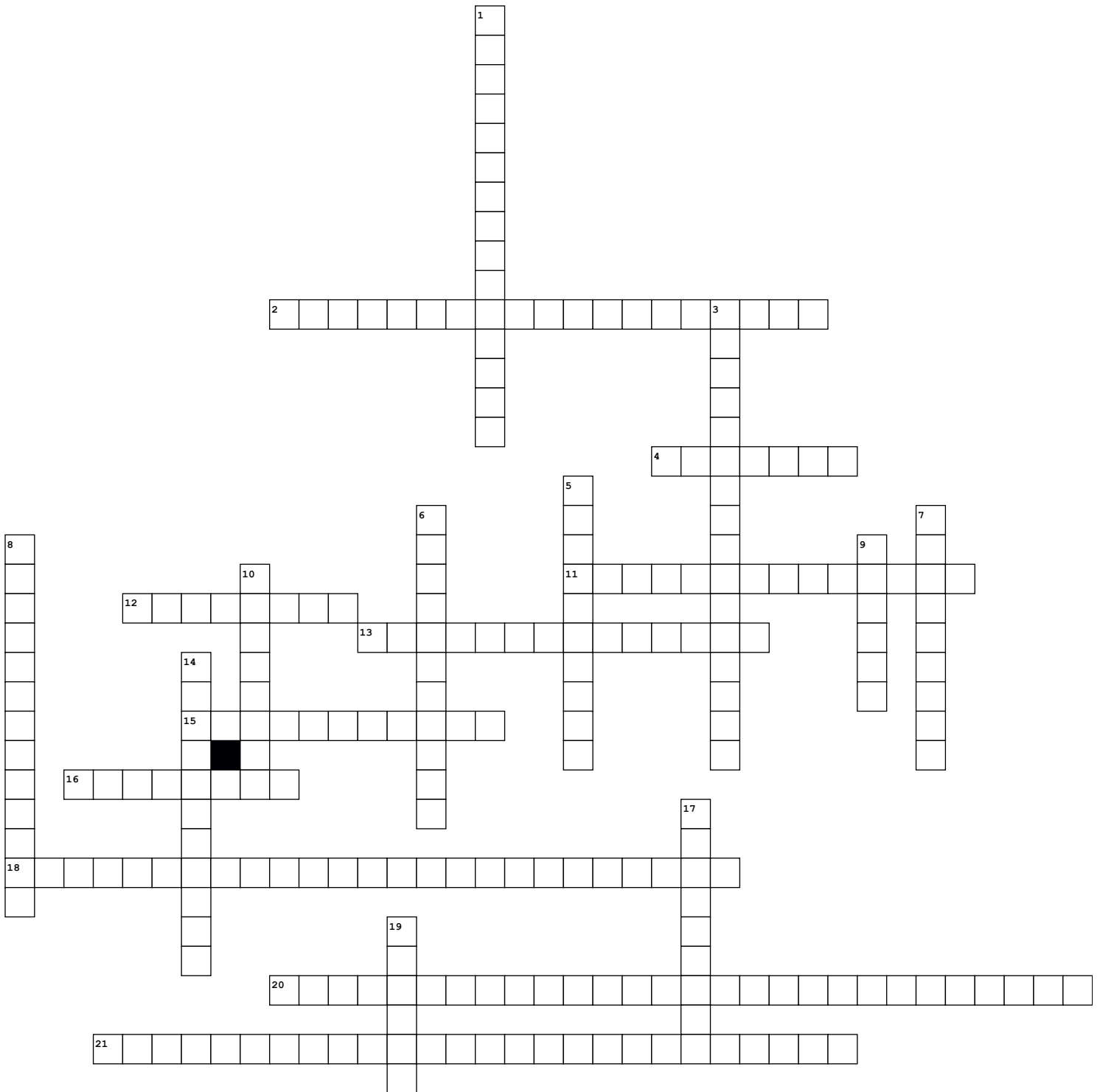


Serenity Crossword Puzzle
