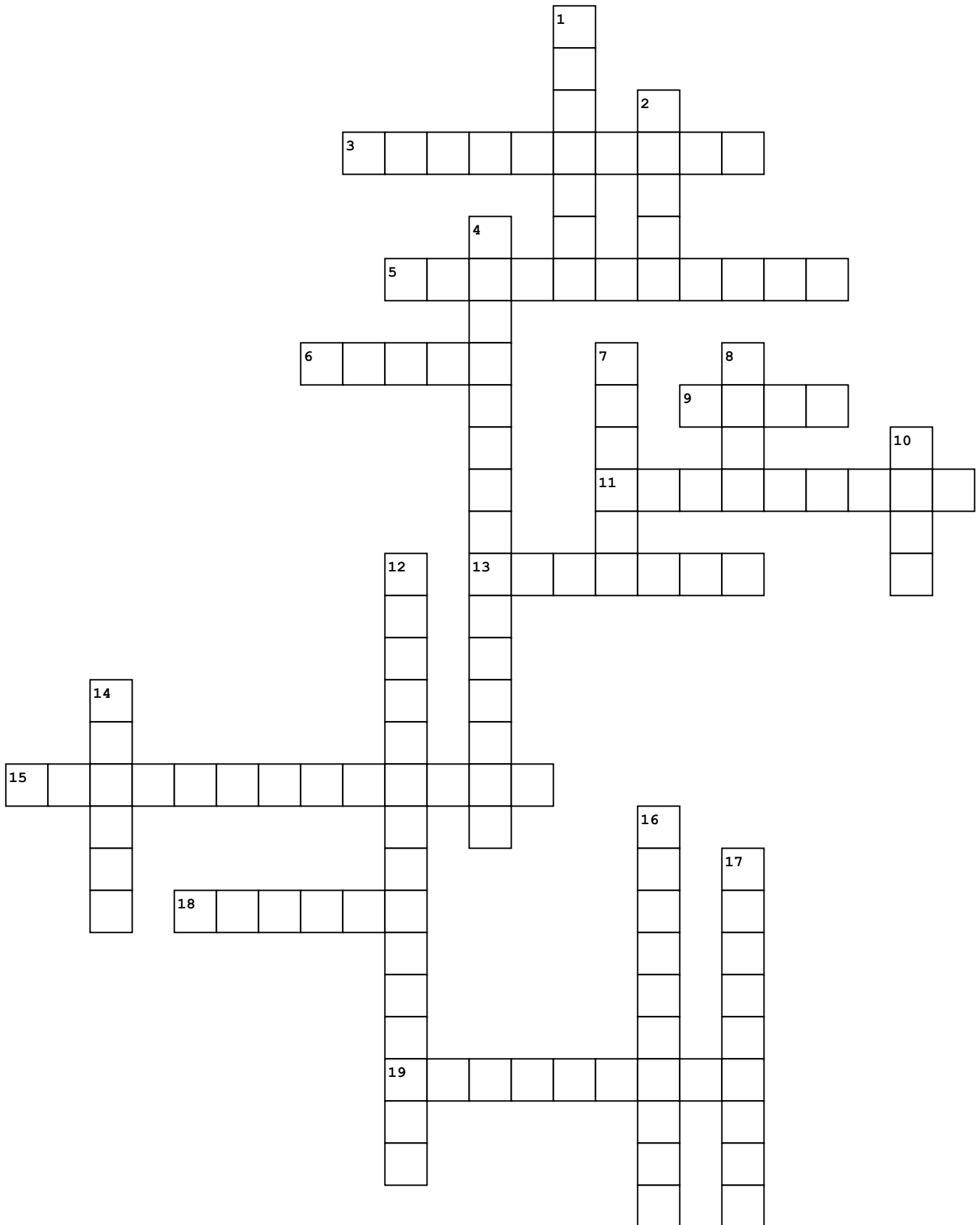


Set Design Terms

- 5.** a stage where the audience sits on three sides
- 6.** offstage right and left
- 9.** an opening in the stage floor
- 11.** objects such as rocks, trees, or ramps onstage
- 13.** a set made up of interchangeable pieces
- 15.** a flexible performance space
- 18.** long pipes or poles from which lights and curtains are hung
- 19.** heavy curtain or flat hung to the sides of the proscenium for changing the width of the proscenium arch.

- 1.** horizontal curtains hung to mask lighting from the audience
- 2.** wooden frame covered by canvas
- 4.** a stage where the audience looks through a frame
- 7.** a set made of two or three walls
- 8.** a painted curtain that forms part of the scenery
- 10.** a pair of drapes on either side of the stage to mask the actors backstage
- 12.** sketch of the front view of a set used
- 14.** heavy curtain hung over the proscenium to reduce the height of the proscenium arch
- 16.** a stage where the audience sits on all sides
- 17.** background curtain typically used for projections
