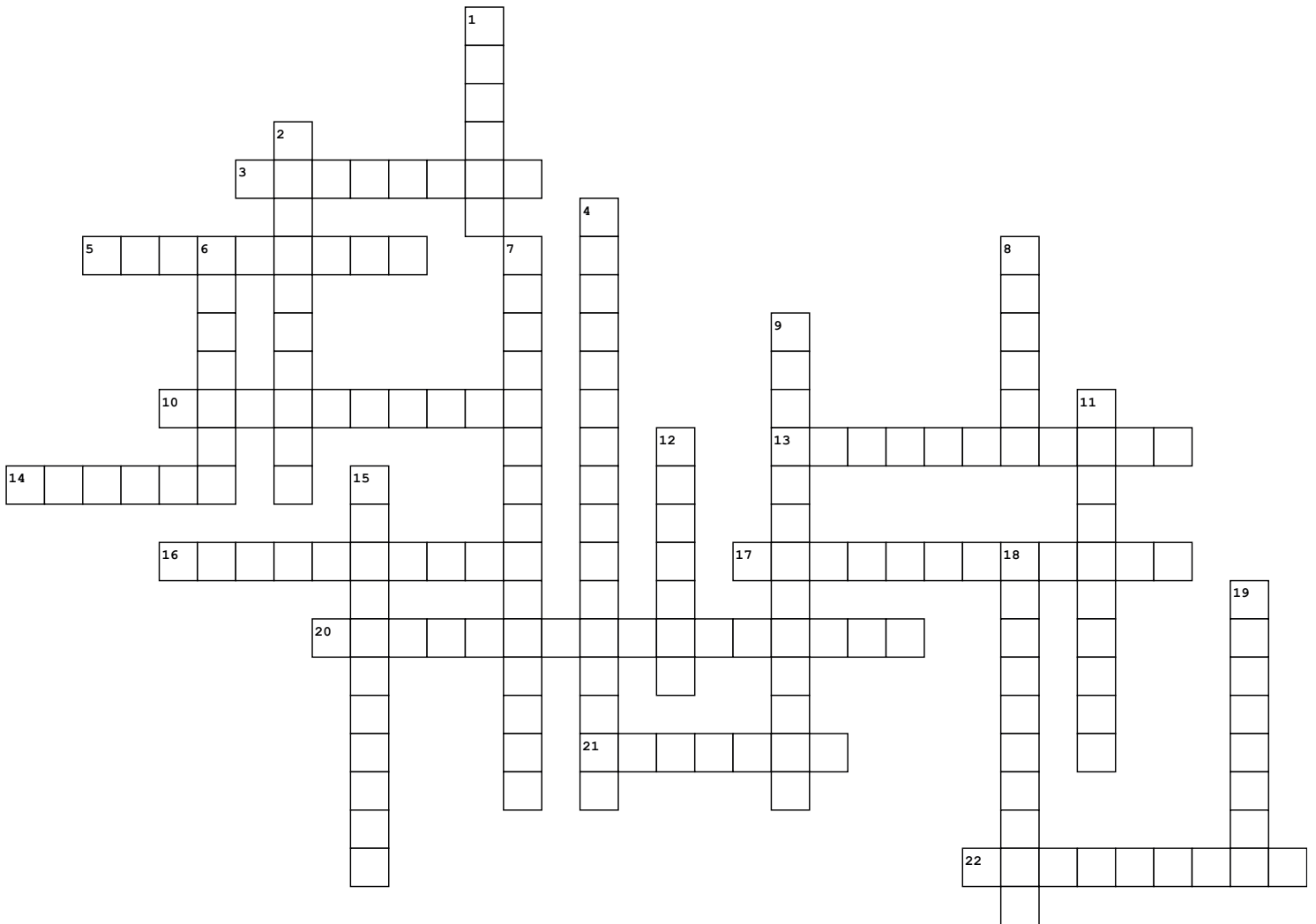


Simon Atlas Crossword
