


The Woodwind Family

2. the smallest member of the woodwind family
4. the family that requires buzzing to create sound
5. The family that has lots of buttons/keys/holes, and requires only air from the player to create sound
6. the instrument that is made of brass, but is in the woodwind family due to using a reed and having lots of keys
8. the small piece of wood used to create sound on some woodwind instruments
10. sister to the piccolo, that looks the same and is a high member of the family

1. the lower of the double reeds and the largest in the family. This is Mrs. Connor's instrument.
3. just below the flute, it has a single reed and may be made of wood or plastic
5. except for the saxophone, all of the family used to be made of this material
6. the clarinet and saxophone use a _____ reed, meaning one piece of wood
7. the highest double reed woodwind instrument
9. the bassoon and the oboe both use a _____ reed, meaning two pieces of wood tied together for
