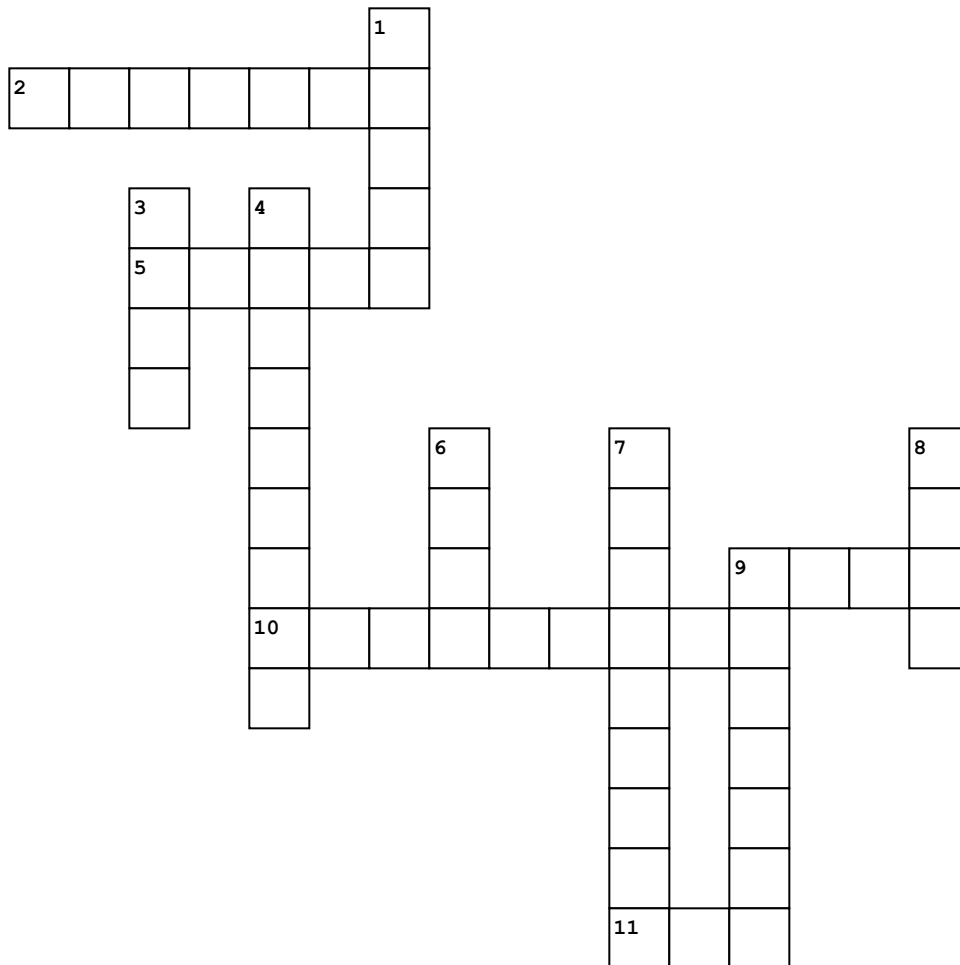

8. The main section of a web page that contains the visible content shown to users.
9. A title or subtitle used to organize content on a web page.
